


# BCS Protocol Timeline



\*The role of the practitioner in this process is to submit case summaries and their respective medical records

<sup>1</sup>Practitioner submits a series of 3 to 20 de-identified cases

<sup>2</sup>Protocol investigators confirm the eligibility of cases.

<sup>3</sup>Practitioner will then be notified which cases meet **all** eligibility criteria and will move forward to patient written consent to give contact information to protocol investigators

<sup>4</sup>CAM practitioner provides detailed medical history and are then notified whether each case is "persuasive" "supportive" or "unevaluable"

<sup>5</sup>Select cases are reviewed by cancer researchers with an expertise in the particular cancer

<sup>6</sup>The Best Case Series review results are summarized and shared with the submitting Practitioner
